The KALS Program Committee has developed a range of classes we trust you will enjoy. However, on-line registration comes with a cost of 3% per transaction to process credit cards and that reduces KALS revenue.

Pricing of Classes has been discussed by the Program Committee and Board and will be a subject for your input at the **Annual Meeting on Sept 24**. Costs for the Society include space rental, staff time, equipment upgrading, phone, etc. Many people take \$5 taster classes and do not purchase an annual membership. The cost of series classes is based on \$6 x number of sessions with a \$40 limit. Prices have not increased for some years. Continued affordability is a concern, so your thoughts will be important to any change.
