VOLUNTEER HOSTS ARE NEEDED Feb 22-25 when Kamloops will again host **THE BC WINTER GAMES** with 2,000 athletes participating in 19 sports.

The 1st BC Winter games were held in Kamloops in 1979 & had 2000 athletes participating in 11 sports. Kamloops proved it could produce the volunteers needed to host an event of this size. Since then the city has hosted many large scale events and the thousands of volunteers needed to support them have enthusiastically joined to work.

Our partners at Kamloops Sports Council are recruiting Hosts for the 4 day event. and are asking volunteers to commit to a minimum of 8 hours from Feb. 22-25. More time would be great. Hosts are needed at all venues and are ambassadors for the Games and the community. They will assist at Games functions, be at Sport venues, assist with Medal Presentation Ceremonies, and escort guests.

Hosts receive a free uniform & will be outfitted in Games gear and are the “face of the games” as they are often the first point of contact for the public at sport venues and special events.
